Show Guidelines

Tables: Exhibitors may purchase 8 foot tables for *Selling and Trading* at \$80 each or Tables for *Display* at \$40 each. **Prices Reduced!!!**

Show Rules:

1. The Show is restricted to Civil War or earlier period memorabilia, relics, books, paper, Veterans' items, and antique or modern art with relevance to the era. Material deemed objectionable by the Show Committee must be removed from tables.
2. Artillery shells and related antique ordnance must be unloaded and safe for display. Those violating this policy will be removed from the Show.
3. Exhibitors must provide covers for their tables.
4. Exhibitors must wear their exhibitor passes at all times during the Show. Lending exhibitor badges to those not named on the badge is prohibited.
5. There will be no selling or trading from Display tables.
6. Souvenir items may not be displayed for sale. The Show Committee shall have full authority to judge whether items displayed violates this rule. Banned material consist of, but are not limited to, bumper stickers, political tracts, T-Shirts, etc.
7. Quality reproduction period merchandise may be sold, but must be clearly advertised as reproductions.
8. Exhibitors are limited to two passes for the first table and one additional pass for the second or any additional table. Non-exhibitors may purchase passes for Dealer Setup times for \$80.
9. All sale tables and exhibits must remain intact until the close of the Show at 5 p.m. on Saturday. Exhibitors leaving early will not be invited back in the future.
10. Armed guard service will be provided during the Show.
11. Dealers and Exhibitors remain responsible for maintaining security over their own tables during the Show. Neither the National Civil War Chaplain's Museum, The Garland-Rodes SCV Camp #409, nor Liberty University assume any responsibility for any loss, theft, or injury that occurs during the Show.
12. This is primarily a Civil War Show; however, World War I and II items for sale or display are welcome.

Table Assignments:

Table assignments will be made upon check in during dealer setup hours. Tables will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. When applicable, Show Committee will honor any reasonable requests by exhibitors.

Awards:

As the Show is meant to promote education about the Civil War, special awards will be made in the following categories, with cash awards indicated for each category:

1. Best of Show. \$500. The exhibit winning this award would score highest in overall artifact appeal and interpretation and exhibit organization and presentation.
2. Best Confederate Exhibit. \$400. The exhibit winning this award would score highest for a Confederate artifact theme. The exhibit should present the object and interpretation to the viewer in a way that clearly conveys information presented.
3. Best Union Exhibit. \$400. The exhibit winning this award would score highest for a Union artifact theme. The exhibit should present the object and interpretation to the viewer in a way that clearly conveys information presented.
4. Most Educational. \$250. The exhibit winning this award would combine the interpretation of the artifacts displayed with general historical events or personalities in a way that would educate students of the war or initiate interest in the subject.
